Do you have a passion for the no-kill philosophy and an affinity for the veterinary surgical environment? We are offering a unique opportunity to help us build a no-kill community through high-quality, high-volume, affordable and accessible spay/neuter services at our community spay/neuter clinic opening in early 2010 in Tucson, Arizona.

The “Spay More Animals” Community Spay/Neuter Clinic is owned and operated by The Center for Animal Rescue and Adoption, a 501c3 nonprofit corporation active in protecting Arizona’s animals since 2002. Our well-equipped clinic will serve the Tucson community and surrounding areas, with a focus on feral cat Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) programs, rescue and adoption groups and low-income families. The Veterinary Technician(s) will work under the direction of the Associate Veterinarian / Spay-Neuter Surgeon. Responsibilities include participating in our high-quality medical protocol through prep of surgical patients, pre- and post-operative animal care, maintenance of inventory and medical records, sterilizing instruments, maintaining outstanding disease-prevention and sanitation procedures, and interfacing with clients during admissions and discharges. We will follow the Humane Alliance model and medical protocol (see [www.HumaneAlliance.org](http://www.HumaneAlliance.org)). Candidates must be comfortable in a high-volume environment that performs early-age spay/neuter and handles feral cats. Three weeks of specialized paid training provided.

Position requires 2-3 years previous experience in a veterinary practice, including administering anesthesia and medications. Candidates also must have excellent organizational, communications, mathematical and teamwork skills, dependability and dedication, and be willing to work in a fast-paced environment while maintaining a superior level of patient care and compassion.
